LUNCH PROGRAMS

Monthly menus will be distributed with options.

Please Note: All in-building MIYJCC camp programs that include lunch will provide a peanut/tree nut-free kosher lunch.

Offsite Campgrounds: Option #1: Full Lunch

Served daily with a great variety of child-friendly kosher meals. A typical meal includes an entree, side dish, salad, fruit, and drink. Each Friday is Pizza Day. On trip days, a boxed lunch is prepared. Every day we offer a sandwich or bagel alternative.

Day Camp fees include lunch. Kosher food options will be offered when available on overnights. For more information, call the Camp Office, x334. A discount is available for campers who bring a bagged lunch each day.

Offsite Campgrounds: Option #2: Brown Bag

If homemade lunches are the way to go, please make sure it's kosher. All children who pack a lunch still receive pizza on Fridays.

MIYJCC: Food Allergy Policies

The JCC Early Childhood Center is a peanut/tree nut-free environment. We will not be serving any snacks or lunches that contain nuts, and we respectfully ask that children who bring their own snacks and/or lunches ensure that all food is peanut/tree nut-free.

The Campgrounds: Products containing peanuts and tree nuts will not be served to our campers. However, there may be traces of peanuts, tree nuts, and other allergens in foods served as they may have been processed in a facility that also contains peanuts. Therefore, we recommend that children with allergies consult with our camp mom prior to starting camp and decide if they should bring their own lunch. If there are children in your child's group with a severe peanut allergy, you will be asked NOT to send peanut butter products.

BEFORE & AFTER CAMP EXTENDED CARE

At the Mid-Island Y JCC

This childcare program is available for children in summer camp programs through 6th grade.

- A cold breakfast will be available in morning childcare.
- Childcare begins at 6:30 am and ends at 6:30 pm.
- Children are accompanied to their bus each morning and are taken off the bus and into our daycare program each afternoon that they are scheduled to attend.
- Rates vary by camp program. Please inquire about rates when you register for a specific camp program.
- Registration for childcare is coordinated with the camp program that your child is enrolled in.

At Our Campgrounds

For those children who are dropped off and picked up at the campgrounds by a parent each day, this service is free.

- Begins at 7:00 am — ends at 6:30 pm

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Enrollment Policies/Fees

- Member applicants must have a valid and paid in full Family Membership at the Mid-Island Y JCC through the end of the summer.
- Requests for adjusted fees based on financial need should be in writing and dropped off to our front office by **4/1**.
- Adjustments and scholarships are processed on a rolling basis.

Deposits & Completion of Payment

- Sailors and Pioneers require a 50% deposit with completed application.
- 4-3-1 program requires a \$1,300 deposit.
- All other camps require a deposit of \$850 per camper.
- Payments may be made by check, cash, VISA, MasterCard, Discover or Amex. A \$50 charge will be applied for bounced checks or denied credit cards.
- Payment of camp fees must be made by **4/1** to ensure camper's admittance to the program, unless on autocharge program.

Payment Plan — You have two payment plan choices

- 1. Autocharge:** If you choose this option, your credit card will be charged the deposit at registration and then a percentage of the amount owed on the 1st of the month, each month, until **6/1**.
- 2. Pay When You Want:** If you choose this option, you will only be charged the deposit amount at time of registration. You can then choose to make payments whenever you wish from time of registration and must be paid in full by **4/1** to hold your child's spot in the program.

Discounts

A \$100 discount for each additional sibling is applied to families enrolled in any of our camping programs.

Refunds

- No refunds will be made after **4/1** for all camp programs due to pre-contracted services such as buses, staff, campground fees and other accommodations.

Cancellations are subject to the following charges:

- Before 2/28: \$100/Camper
- After 2/28 and before 4/1: \$500/Camper
- No refunds after 4/1

There are no pro-rated fee reductions or refunds for any reason such as missed days due to act of God, illness, absence, early withdrawal, suspension or dismissal.


